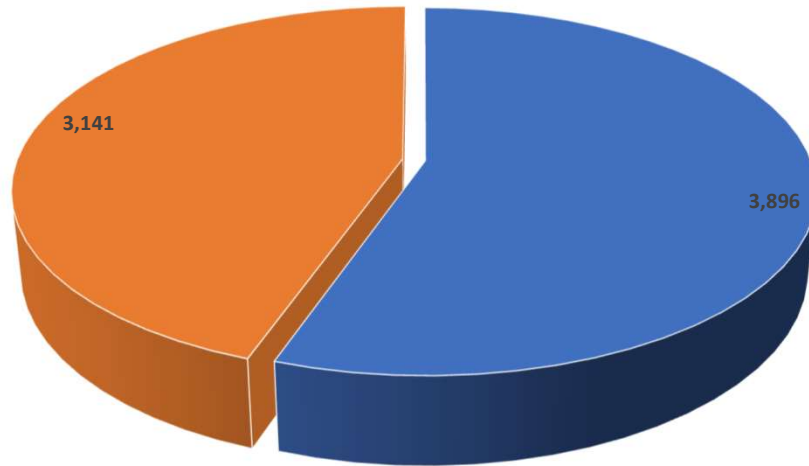

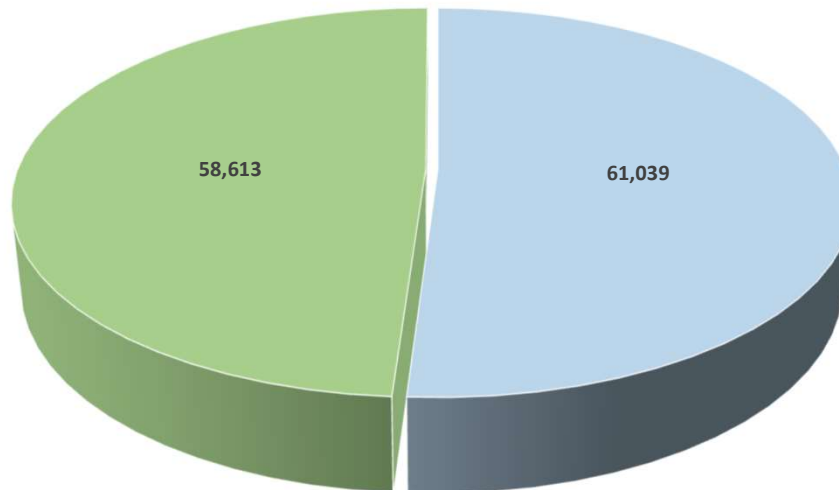
### Orleans Parish Improved Commercial Assessment Changes 2023 vs 2024

#### COUNT OF ASSESSMENT CHANGES ABOVE AND BELOW 9 PERCENT

State law requires all tax recipient agencies to reduce their millage rates following a quadrennial reassessment (2024). Other than the Orleans Parish School Board, all tax recipient agencies reduced their millage rate; the School Board kept their 2023 millage rate. The result was a 9 percent decrease in the millage rate. The chart indicates the total improved parcel count of 61,754 residential and commercial properties with an assessment change above 9 percent (paid more in 2024 property taxes) and 64,935 residential and commercial properties with an assessment change below 9 percent (paid less in 2024 property taxes). The chart excludes all unimproved real properties, exempt real properties and new construction properties.
